Ms. Hillman,

By now, you probably received the notice from the EA consultants that the final reports are available on the project website and are way ahead of me. I received the notice last night as well, but was in a budget workshop, so didn't get to send it on to you. I'm sure it will be helpful to have plenty of time to review the materials prior to the Sept. 8th meeting.

Other updates:

The postcard mailing for the meeting notice is in process right now and should be arriving in homes in the next 4-5 days. Centennial's letter to border properties is in development and should go out early next week. It will have more information about the potential property impacts and encourage those residents to continue to be involved in the EA process. Sept. 8th is Public Meeting #2 (of 3) besides the Centennial specific meeting that was requested by your neighborhood. That special meeting has been discussed, but not scheduled. The thought is to get more of the studies completed to let property owners know what the actual impacts might be and then schedule that meeting. Right now, I'm hearing very minimal ROW property needed, but want to be sure everyone is carefully monitoring the situation.

SEPTEMBER 8th IS NOT THE FINAL MEETING NOR COMPLETION OF THE EA PROCESS. More exact studying of the partial improved cloverleaf needs to be done and the EA will include at least one more public open house.
