 - A. Approval of bills

D. Report from the Chair

- Suhaka urged the members of the Board to register for Ting internet service at www.ting.com/centennial.
- There is a growing problem in Walnut Hills. An outside investor is buying properties (2 so far, 3rd one coming) and converting them to duplexes. This is illegal. This is a neighborhood of single-family residences. Suhaka is pursuing the issue with the City.

Old Business

- A. Ice Cream Social, ice cream supply, Pole, absent
- B. WHCA D&O Insurance, Suhaka
 - We have paid \$633 for \$1million coverage. I believe it started on 15 Oct.
- C. Electronic recycling, Suhaka
 - We cannot pay any less for our recycling. Consensus was to skip 2017 and bring it back the next year (2018). Suhaka will write a small item in *Newsletter* asking the community if they would be willing to pay \$10 for the service.

 - We've received the invoice for the rental of the school: CCSD bill of permit, \$35; room rental, \$285; total, \$320. It hasn't been paid, yet.
- B. Annual Meeting, March 9, 2017: Odd #
 - Odd neighborhood's will be up for election. Fazal has stepped down and Marsicek will not continue. We need to try to replace them.
 - Ask CDOT to present.
- C. Disc Golf tournament, Bern
 - We will keep our eyes open for the Metrum and SSPRD matching gift grants and plan to install as many more baskets as we can get the money, at least 3 more.
 - The tournament is scheduled for 9 Sept.
- D. Willow Bend parking lot: has passed all it's hearings and will begin to tear down the house. Boyd will have to mitigate asbestos first.
